At age 92, Mrs. Rosanell Eaton was among the 120 people who chose to engage in civil disobedience Monday, June 24, at the NC General Assembly and bear a moral witness to the extremist, reactionary policies flowing through the People's House. A 70-year member of the NAACP, who at one time was forced to memorize sections of the constitution in order to vote (often by illiterate white people), Mrs. Eaton spoke with grace and power in front of the Senate chambers as thousands rallied outside during another Moral Monday.



**“The Pain Begins...”** The NC General Assembly and the Governor have launched an all-out attack on voters, unemployed workers and poor children, women and men! • **70,000** North Carolinians lose their only source of sustenance on **July 1** because they decided to deny them unemployment benefits, with **100,000 more** losing them by the end of the year. • The ultra-conservatives pounced on a Tea Party US Supreme Court decision to **gut the Voting Rights Act**, the crown jewel of the Civil Rights Movement, by bringing legislation that would create a 21st Century **poll tax disguised as Voter ID**.
